

Doctor of Medicine Degree Program Year 2 – Preclinical Class of 2027 Academic Year 2024-2025

Required USMLE Question Bank

For academic year (AY) 2024-2025 tuition bill, there is a \$20 balance due for UWorld USMLE Step 1. WMed purchased, on your behalf in October 2023, a discounted Step 1 UWorld subscription for 540-days (18-months) for \$599, a savings of \$399 from the retail list price of \$998. Since the cost of this extended subscription (18-month versus 12-month) was higher than quoted in the 2023-2024 textbook list, WMed paid \$100 toward a portion of the subscription rate.

The medical school will purchase on your behalf a discounted subscription to UWorld to successfully prepare and sit for the clerkship shelf exams in addition to the USMLE Step 2.

Thus, students *should not* individually purchase their UWorld USMLE Step 2 subscription prior to the start of the Core Clerkship. Your account and access information will be provided to you in the first week of Rotation 1 (March 2025) to activate.
