**USMLE Step 1 Study Tools**

The WMed faculty supports the use of USMLE-style question banks as an effective tool for study and test preparation. The medical school will purchase on your behalf discounted subscriptions to Pathoma, ScholarRx, and UWorld for preparation for the USMLE Step 1 exam.

Students *should not* purchase individual subscriptions to Pathoma, ScholarRx, or UWorld for Step 1, as prior individual payments cannot be retroactively applied or refunded by the school or vendor.

The Medical Library will provide your Pathoma and ScholarRx accounts and access information during the first week of classes. You will receive your UWorld account and instructions on how to activate it during the first semester of your first year, around mid-October. The Office of Student Affairs will communicate additional details regarding UWorld distribution.

**Important Note:** If you decide to take a leave of absence (LOA) after receiving and activating your Pathoma and UWorld accounts, you cannot suspend and reactivate your subscription later. You must use the subscriptions within the subscribed period, because Pathoma and UWorld do not provide free extensions for unused time. WMed will not refund any unused portion of your subscriptions.

If you delay taking the USMLE Step 1 exam, both Pathoma and UWorld offer discounted extension options (available by the week or month) before your initial subscription expires. It is an additional cost that you must arrange and purchase on your own.

For an additional 3 months of Pathoma online videos *prior to* the expiration of the 21-month subscription, please email your request to Ask.Librarian@wmed.edu.

The ScholarRx subscription *can be* temporarily suspended and reactivated upon return from leave of absence (LOA). If you need online access beyond the initial 24-month subscription period, there is an additional cost for you to purchase an extension at <https://usmlerx.com/pricing>.

### **Medical First Responder Course**

The medical school will purchase the BDLS course and online materials from the National Disaster Life Support Foundation (NDLSF) on your behalf. The course instructor will provide your BDLS course access information on the first day of class.

To successfully complete the Medical First Responder course, all students must rent the required textbook individually from VitalSource.
