Thus, **students *should not* individually purchase** their UWorld USMLE Step 1 – 540-day subscription. UWorld will not apply it retroactively on a prior order or issue a refund to an individual for this new subscription purchase. **Your account and access information will be provided to you** in the first semester of the first year of medical school (**mid-October 2024**). Further communication will be provided through Student Affairs regarding this group purchase.
