

# Doctor of Medicine Degree Program Year 1- Preclinical Class of 2027 Academic Year 2023-2024

WMed faculty embraces a format-neutral environment where learners select the medium that best meets their learning preferences. Required textbooks support the delivery of curricular content identified by the faculty to facilitate a balanced, chronological presentation of new material to the learner. Therefore, students will be responsible for acquiring required textbooks and given the following options, purchasing or renting an online digital book from <a href="VitalSource">VitalSource</a>, purchasing or renting a print textbook from a third-party bookseller, or accessing through the <a href="Medical Library's online collection">Medical Library's online collection</a>, when available. Pre-clinical course textbooks are used in both the first and second years of medical school and should be purchased or accessed online from the library rather than rented.

For the Medical First Responder course, taught in the Transitions to Medical School, all students must individually purchase the required textbook from <u>VitalSource</u> in order to successfully complete the course.
