For academic year (AY) 2025-2026 tuition bill, there is a \$100 balance due for UWorld USMLE Step 2. WMed purchased, on your behalf in March 2025, a discounted Step 2 UWorld subscription for 540-days (18 months) for \$599, a saving of \$439 from the retail list price of \$1,038.

Important Note: You cannot suspend and later reactivate your UWorld subscription if you take a leave of absence (LOA) after receiving and activating your Step 2 account. UWorld requires that you use the Qbank within the subscription period and will not grant free extensions for unused time. WMed will not refund any unused portions of your subscription. If you delay taking the USMLE Step 2 exam, UWorld offers a heavily discounted rate to extend access by the week or month before your initial subscription expires. It is an additional cost that you must arrange and purchase on your own.
