Therefore, students are responsible for obtaining the required textbooks and are given the following options:

- Purchasing or renting an online digital book from <u>VitalSource</u>
- Purchasing or renting a print textbook from a third-party bookseller

For the Medical First Responder course, all students must individually purchase the required textbook from <u>VitalSource</u> to successfully complete the course.

The WMed faculty embraces the advantages of incorporating USMLE-style question banks for study and test preparations. . The medical school will purchase on your behalf a discounted Pathoma and UWorld subscriptions to prepare for the USMLE Step 1 exam.

Thus, students should not individually purchase their Pathoma or UWorld USMLE Step 1 subscriptions. Pathoma and UWorld will not apply prior payment retroactively or issue a refund to an individual. Your account and access information will be **provided to you** in the first semester of your first year of medical school (mid-September). Further communication will be provided through Student Affairs regarding this group purchase.

**Important Note:** If you decide to take a leave of absence (LOA) after you receive and activate your Pathoma and UWorld accounts, your subscription *cannot* be suspended and reactivated later. Course materials must be used within the subscribed period, as Pathoma and UWorld do not provide free extensions for unused time. WMed will not refund any unused portions of your subscriptions. If you delay taking the USMLE Step exam, Pathoma and UWorld offer a heavily discounted rate to extend access by the week or month before your initial subscription expires. It is an additional cost that you must arrange and purchase your own.

## **Required Learning Tools**

On your behalf, the medical school negotiated an online subscription to both Year 1 and Year 2 of <u>ScholarRx</u>. Additionally, the medical school will purchase the BDLS course and online materials from the National Disaster Life Support Foundation (NDLSF). Thus, students **should not** purchase individual subscriptions before the start of the academic year. The Medical Library will provide you with your ScholarRx account and access information during the first week of classes; the course instructor will provide your BDLS course access information on the first day of class.
